Student Eligibility:

- 1. Student has aken all regular courses offered that cover relevant background material for the project/topic
- 2. Student has aminimum of a B (3.0) GPA
- 3. Student must be in the major or minor in the department hosting the DS.
- 4. Student has accumulated teast 60credits toward degree
- 5. Transfer students must have at least 30 credit Datroit Mercybefore eligible
- 6. Guest students are not eligible

Time Obligation:

- 1. Student should be prepared to spend a minimum of 30 hours foh eaedit hour registered
- 2. A 3-credit hour course implies about 9 hours of work per week on the part of the student including time meeting with the instructor.
- 3. Student must meet with the instructor regularly with no less than one hour every ortbek.

Limitations:
